When The Lincoln Square Theater first welcomed audiences in 1916, its grand interior, glittering lights, and live acts made it the pride of Decatur. Families flocked downtown to catch the latest picture show, watch vaudeville troupes, and mingle under the bright marquee. For decades, The Lincoln buzzed with life, its neon sign glowing as a symbol of the city's spirit.

But like many downtown districts, economic downturns and shifting entertainment trends brought tough years. While other historic theaters closed for good, Decatur refused to let its crown jewel fade. Passionate volunteers, local leaders, and everyday citizens came together to save The Lincoln — brick by brick, seat by seat — restoring not just a building but a place for connection.

Today, The Lincoln has reclaimed its place as a beloved community gathering spot. It hosts major concerts, local theater, touring acts, and special movie nights. From nostalgic films to high-energy rock shows, there's something on stage for everyone — and each show brings people out to explore downtown again.

#### More Than Entertainment - We're an Economic Engine

Each event at The Lincoln Square Theater draws hundreds — sometimes over a thousand — visitors downtown. It's common to see families sharing meals before a show, friends gathering for drinks after a concert, or visitors staying overnight in Decatur to experience our history.

Local restaurants see higher weekend traffic. Shops stay open later. Neighborhood businesses get the boost they need to grow and hire. When our marquee lights up, it's a signal that downtown Decatur is open for business.

- 65,000+ annual guests and growing many from nearby towns like Springfield, Champaign, Bloomington, St. Louis.
- 70% of our audience shops or dines downtown before or after events.
- Visitors spend an estimated \$100–\$200 per person in local shops, restaurants, and accommodations during a night out at The Lincoln.

This ripple effect is exactly why historic venues like ours are essential for small cities: they drive foot traffic, anchor redevelopment, and make downtown a destination once again.
